This instrument uses a maple neck, which has a distressed finish. The finish itself is hand colored and hand rubbed. There are seven coats of tung oil varnish.

The dimensions conform to standard 4/4 full size violin standards. Length is 23-5/8", the box width is 5-1/2", and the body is 1-1/2" thick.



This lovely old cigar box is not as fragile as it appears. It was extensively repaired and strengthened before being made into a violin.



This violin is dressed in deluxe Basswood fittings with Ebony trim. The strings are Super Sensitive Octava medium gauge.



The fingerboard is hand crafted figured maple.



The distressed finish is apparent in this view of the underside of the body.
